Said guardian will be solely responsible for all expenses for the examination and will provide a written notice of findings and completion of said exam within seven (7) days after completion to the Horse Rescue, Relief and Retirement Fund, Inc, 1768 Newt Green Road, Cumming, GA 30040

The horse remains the property of the HRRRFI. This animal will be maintained and cared for under this agreement for a period of four (4) years. Upon receipt of satisfactory veterinary report, this agreement may be extended for a period of four (4) more years and each four (4) years thereafter.

If this offer is accepted by HRRRFI, said guardian agrees that said animal shall reside in the minimum corral space of three hundred (300) square feet, constructed of wood, pipe or horse-safe wire. Sanitary living conditions must be provided with a shelter from the elements and proper inoculations as recommended by HRRRFI. **Said guardian understands and agrees that said animal may not be sold to an individual or for slaughter, nor bred, given away, leased, removed from the personal supervision or moved from described address herein without the prior WRITTEN approval of the HRRRFI.** If said guardian is proved in violation of any of the above, said guardian shall be subject to legal action. Said guardian agrees that an authorized representative from HRRRFI may enter the property where said animal resides to determine if all conditions of this agreement are being complied with. Should said guardian violate any of these terms, an authorized representative of HRRRFI may enter said land where animal resides and take possession of said animal.

Said guardian further agrees to accept all responsibility for any action or lien resulting from any action, directly or indirectly, involving said animal while in said guardian's care. Therefore said guardian agrees and understands that neither the HRRRFI nor any of its employees or agents will be liable for damages or injury caused to said guardian or a third person by said animal once said guardian receives delivery of it, including, but not limited to, damages or injuries caused by the fact that the animal does not perform or behave in a manner said guardian expected. Further, if any third person makes a claim against the HRRRFI or any of its employees or agents as a result of any conduct of the animal after said guardian has taken possession, said guardian agrees to indemnify and hold the HRRRFI and its employees or agents harmless from any claim, including costs and attorney's fees resulting from such claim.

Said guardian will be responsible for returning the horse to the HRRRFI or said guardian will pay costs involved in its return by an authorized representative of HRRRFI at the end of the agreed period, if said guardian is unable to care for the said animal, or if said guardian is found in default of any conditions of this agreement. In the event of said guardian's death, during this agreement, said guardian directs the funds from said guardian's estate to be used to return the horse described herein to the HRRRFI.

If the animal is determined by a veterinarian to be in a debilitated or unhealthy condition on return, said guardian will assume responsibility for all costs incurred to return animal to a healthy condition.

GUARDIANSHIP PROCEDURE

Horse Rescue, Relief and Retirement Fund, Inc. Long Term and Short Term Guardianship Procedures

1. Read and fill out Long Term or Short Term Guardianship form.
2. Mail the completed form to HRRRF, Inc. All paperwork must be completed.
3. Meet with a representative from the rescue to discuss your needs and desires to have guardianship over a rescued horse(s).
4. The boarding facility that you select or your own farm must meet HRRRF, Inc. guidelines and will be visited by a rescue representative.
5. Once you have been matched with an appropriate horse(s) and your boarding facility or your own farm has been approved by HRRRF, Inc., transportation may then be arranged for your horse(s) to be moved to the new location.
- 6. After completion of the above procedures guardians make a donation to help defray the veterinary, farrier, and feed costs incurred with rescuing the horse(s) you have selected as well as the cost of future equine. Donations usually range between \$300 - \$1,000 or more; all funds are used for the benefit of the rescue process.**
