

Volunteer Position Available

Sponsorship Coordinator

Location: Save the Horses, Cumming, GA & Talking Rock, GA

Compensation: None. Volunteer position (non-paid)

Schedule: Work from home and meet sponsors at the rescue as needed.

Duties: Meet potential sponsors at the rescue or arrange for an experienced volunteer to meet them. Give them a tour of the farm and introduce them to horses that are available to be sponsored. Maintain the sponsor database in Excel.

Activities:

- Respond to all sponsor requests that come from the adoption email box.
- Email or call the person who is interested and find out what information they need.
- Meet potential sponsors at the rescue or arrange for an experienced volunteer to meet them. Give them a tour of the farm and introduce them to horses that are available to be sponsored.
- Work closely with Cheryl for information on animals available for sponsorship.
- Maintain the Sponsor tab on the census spreadsheet.
- Notify adoption team when there is a new sponsor.
- Periodically work with Michelle Williams to reconcile the list of sponsors and monthly amounts.
- As needed, attend special events at the rescue such as Hay Day, Deck the Stalls, etc., to promote and answer questions about the sponsorship program.
- Ensure that all sponsors that want to interact with the selected horse have attended volunteer orientation.

Some horse experience preferred, but we will train a person that demonstrates commitment and dedication to helping children & animals.

Regular Duties:

- Set up picnic area with tablecloth and decorations.
- Manage volunteers
- Groom and tack horses
- Organize pony rides Help children on/off horses Walk the horses.
- Monitor/supervise children as they paint horses (help children apply paint to their hands and paint the horse.)
- Monitor/supervise children at the petting zoo
- Clean up before & after the party
- Put tack, decorations & tablecloth away
